2. The rate should be quoted as per the sector given above and will be selected for the Lowest Quoted Rate.
3. Airline must be confirmed while submitting the quotation
4. The validation of fares and availability of seats should be as per the details mentioned above.
5. The successful bidder should submit the photocopy of every air ticket along with their invoices for payment.
6. unconditional quotations like an increase of fares or changes of airlines at the time of travel are not accepted.
7. In case the lowest evaluated bidder withdraws the bid then the second lowest evaluated bidder shall be awarded to purchase and issue the air tickets at the cost and risk of the 1<sup>st</sup> lowest bidder and the difference of amount per traveller shall have to be borne by the 1<sup>st</sup> lowest bidder unconditionally.
8. Copy to valid Licence should be submitted along with bid.
